ORDER APPROVING AMENDMENTS
TO THE INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT

This matter came before Chairman Tre Hargett, Director Sara Kyle and Director Mary Freeman of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on July 14, 2008 to consider the Petition for approval of the amendments to the interconnection agreement negotiated between BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. and BellSouth Long Distance, Inc.¹ filed on June 24, 2008.²

Based upon a review of the amendments, the record in this matter, and the standards for review set forth in 47 U.S.C. § 252, the Directors made findings consistent with those in the *Order Approving the Interconnection Agreement* issued on October 27, 2005 in Docket No. 05-00213 and unanimously granted the Petition.
