ORDER GRANTING APPROVAL OF NAME CHANGE

This matter came before Chairman Tre Hargett, Director Eddie Roberson, and Director Sara Kyle of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority" or "TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on July 28, 2008, upon the Application of Quantumshift Communications, Inc. ("Quantumshift" or "Company") to change its name.


QuantumShift was granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") as a reseller or telecommunication operator service provider as MVX.COM Communications, Inc. ("MVX.COM") in Docket No. 99-00677. At a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on July 10, 2001, in Docket No. 01-00546, the Directors found that MVX.COM had met all the TRA requirements for changing its name and approved the change to QuantumShift Communications, Inc. On June 25, 2008, QuantumShift filed an Application to change its name to QuantumShift Communications, Inc. d/b/a vCom Solutions.

Based upon careful consideration of the record of this matter and upon a finding that the Company has satisfied the requirements of Tenn. Comp. R. & Regs. 1220-4-1-.08, a majority of the panel voted to approve the name change.
