Dear Mayor Morris:

On July 1, 2008, AT&T filed an application with the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA") for a state-issued certificate of franchise authority in accordance with the Competitive Cable and Video Services Act ("CCVSA"). On July 3, the TRA Staff issued a letter to the cities and counties listed in that application requesting, in part, the number of public, educational and governmental ("PEG") access channels that have been activated in your jurisdiction. The TRA posted a response to their letter from your office, and that response indicates that PEG access channels have been activated in your jurisdiction.

As we develop plans to deploy our video service in Tennessee, we will need to work with those individuals responsible for operating PEG access channels so that we can incorporate this programming into our video product, as required by the CCVSA. Therefore, we are requesting that you provide the name and contact information for the individual(s) in your area who are responsible for operating the PEG access channel(s) referenced in your response to the TRA's letter.

Please note that this letter is not intended to provide any notice about deploying our video service in your area. Your office will receive a separate letter notifying you of video service deployment in your jurisdiction at the appropriate time.
