FIRST AMENDED CERTIFICATE OF FRANCHISE AUTHORITY

On November 26, 2008, pursuant to Public Chapter No. 932,¹ also known as the Competitive Cable and Video Services Act (the "CCVSA"), BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Tennessee ("AT&T") filed with the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA") an *Amendment to Certificate of Franchise Authority* to supplement certain municipalities and unincorporated areas within counties² to those areas previously described within its application filed July 1, 2008. As no basis for denial of the amendment under section 6(i)(1) of the CCVSA has been alleged, the TRA hereby issues the First Amended Certificate of Franchise Authority to the original Certificate of Franchise Authority issued to AT&T on August 5, 2008.
