SECOND AMENDED CERTIFICATE OF FRANCHISE AUTHORITY

On December 10, 2008, pursuant to Public Chapter No. 932,¹ also known as the Competitive Cable and Video Services Act (the "CCVSA"), BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Tennessee ("AT&T") filed with the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA") a *Second Amendment to Certificate of Franchise Authority* to supplement certain municipalities and unincorporated areas within counties² to those areas previously described within its application filed July 1, 2008 and previous amendments thereto. As no basis for denial of the amendment under section 6(i)(1) of the CCVSA has been alleged, the TRA hereby issues the Second Amended Certificate of Franchise Authority to supplement the original and all previous amendments of the Certificate of Franchise Authority issued to AT&T on August 5, 2008.
