Re: Request for Information to City of Collegedale

## Gentlemen:

We are in receipt of your Notice and Request for Information letter dated July 27, 2010. The letter posed two questions:

- (A) The number of activated PEG channels for each municipality or county, as well as the number authorized to be activated, if different.
- (B) The terms of any PEG support payments being provided by the incumbent service provider.

In response, the City of Collegedale has two approved cable television franchises, with Comcast and the Electric Power Board of Chattanooga. The terms of each franchise agreement as they relate to the PEG channel are the same:

Section 1) -- Public, Educational & Governmental Access Channels and Emergency Alert System Required.

- a) The Grantee shall provide, without charge and subject to the requirements of the Federal Communications Commission, an Emergency Alert System ("EAS"), or successor to that system, complying with the requirement currently set forth in FCC regulations that a Cable System transmit a visual EAS message on at least one Channel and that the Cable System also provide video interruption and audio EAS message on all Channels with the video further stating which Channel is carrying the visual message. Only Federal, state, and local EAS messages shall be transmitted on the EAS system. In establishing its EAS system, the Grantee shall, in accordance with FCC or other applicable regulations, cooperate with the City on the use and operation by the City of the Emergency Alert System.
- b) The Grantee shall reserve a minimum of one (1) nonexclusive Channel for public, educational and governmental (PEG) access use.

This provision is the extent of each contract as it relates to PEG channels. To the best of our knowledge, each franchisee operates one PEG channel.
