FIFTEENTH AMENDED CERTIFICATE OF FRANCHISE AUTHORITY

On November 16, 2011, pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 7-59-301, et seq., also known as the Competitive Cable and Video Services Act ("CCVSA"), BellSouth Telecommunications, LLC, d/b/a AT&T Tennessee ("AT&T") filed with the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA") a Fifteenth Amendment to Certificate of Franchise Authority.
