TWENTY-FIRST AMENDMENT TO CERTIFICATE OF FRANCHISE AUTHORITY

AT&T acknowledges the provisions of Section 7-59-312 relevant to enforcement of non-discrimination and deployment requirements.

AT&T has submitted the required amendment fee of \$250 with this amendment, based on the population of the area designated above.
