On behalf of Mayor Jerry Garrett, I am in receipt of your letter of July 3, 2008 advising the City of Goodlettsville of AT&T's application to the TRA to provided cable and video service in the City. Your letter was dated July 3, 2008; however it was not delivered to the City until July 11, 2008.

You are seeking comments from the City on this matter. The City of Goodlettsville has not received a notice from AT&T or BellSouth as your letter suggests. However, the Tennessee Municipal League has provided me with a copy of the application. In the spirit of cooperation, I am providing the following comments on this application.

- Comcast provides one (1) local government access channel to the citizens of Goodlettsville.
 While the Metro-Government of Nashville and Davidson County presently administers this channel, the City of Goodlettsville will administer any channels provided under Public Chapter 932 by BellSouth Telecommunications d/b/a AT&T Corporation. Concurrent with this correspondence, I have notified BellSouth of our intentions via a copy of this letter.
- 2. Comcast is not required to provide the City with any PEG support payments.

Thank you in advance for your assistance in this matter.
