
Dear Chairman Hargett:

All members of the public, please take notice that on September 8, 2008 at 1:00 PM, the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA") will hold a public hearing on the ground floor at its office at 460 James Robertson Parkway, Nashville, Tennessee to consider the proposed Settlement Agreement between HC Sewage Treatment, LLC and the TRA staff on April 4, 2008 to increase the rates and charges for sewage treatment service.

On April 4, 2008, HC Sewage Treatment, LLC and the TRA staff filed a Petition to change and increase the rates and charges for sewage treatment with the TRA. The monthly service rate and increases have been proposed because the utility's existing rates do not produce sufficient revenue to permit the utility to meet its operating expenses which are necessary for the utility to operate sewage treatment services for its customers in accordance with all requirements of the TRA and the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation. In the Petition filed on April 4, 2008, HC Sewage Treatment and the TRA staff requested an annual increase in revenue for a total yearly revenue of \$44,100. This will result in an increase in the monthly base rate for sewage treatment from \$100.00 to \$200.00 for the 1st 10,000 gallons and an increase of the Volumetric Rate from \$0.01 to \$0.0557645. No other rates will be changed.

HC Sewage Treatment, LLC and the TRA staff request that the rates pursuant to the Settlement Agreement become effective immediately on the approval of the TRA authority conference.

A complete copy of the Petition filed by HC Sewage Treatment and the TRA staff for a rate increase and the proposed Settlement Agreement are on file with the Tennessee Regulatory Authority.
