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Petition of Tennessee Wastewater Systems, Inc. To amend its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity

Tennessee Wastewater Systems, Inc. ("TWSI") petitions the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA") to amend TWSI's Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to expand its service area to include a portion of Giles County known as the Tarpley Shop Utility District. The first area being served will be the intersection of Highway 64 and Interstate 65 at Exit 14 off of Interstate 65. Our first commercial customer being served will be Pilot. See the attached letters from Brad Alsup, project manager for Pilot Travel Centers, LLC, as well as the Giles County Executive and the President of the Tarpley Shop Utility District regarding service to this project. We have had numerous other inquiries regarding service in this area which will impact the final design capacity of the facility.

We are proposing a deep cell lagoon treatment and dispersal system that has a projected capacity of approximately 75,000 gallons per day and could be expanded later if desired. The system will have the capacity to serve numerous developments throughout the area. The territory includes the Tarpley Shop Utility District surrounded in green on the maps enclosed (see attached "Exhibit A"). The exact maps and parcels for a service area this large are far too numerous to list accurately.

Commercial customers will be charged according to flow and waste strength. Residential customers will be charged according to residential Rate Class 5, currently set at \$31.36 as of the date of this submittal. We are withholding submittal of the TDEC application for a permit until we have a more firm assessment of the size of the treatment facility. It is the intention of the parties that TWSI will own the collection, treatment, and dispersal system and will own a permanent easement on the property that the system occupies.

After approval, the construction of the system, which is comprised of watertight effluent collection, deep cell lagoon treatment, and subsurface drip dispersal, will take approximately 180 days to complete. The estimated value of the contribution in aid of the construction of the initial wastewater system is approximately \$800,000.00.

A minimum of \$100 per month will be charged for up to the first 300 gallons per day of design flow expected. (Except off-site which will have a \$94.00 minimum plus pass through costs.) For each additional 100 gallons per day of design flow expected, up to a total of 1,000 gallons per day, an additional charge of \$18.00 per month per 100 gallons will be levied. For design flows expected over 1,000 gallons per day, up to 3,000 gallons per day, the following monthly charges per 1,000 gallons of daily flow will apply.

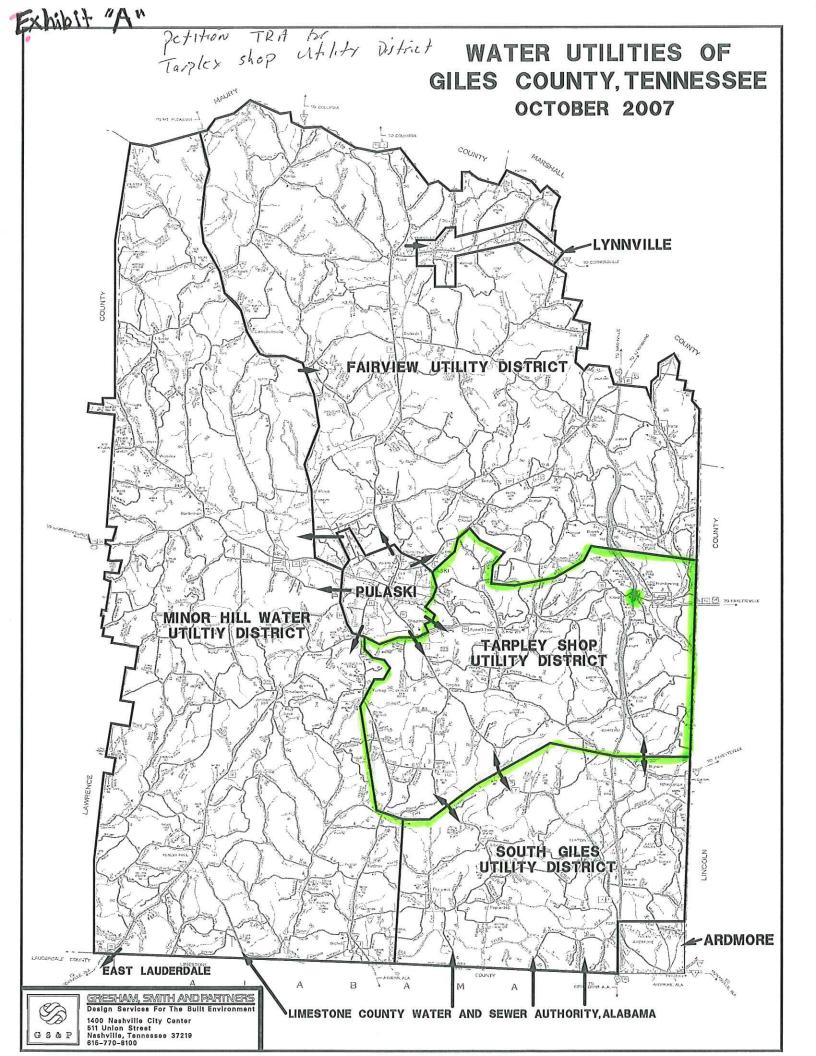

Upon entry of an Order that finds a monetary obligation pursuant to Chapter 1220-4-13, the Authority may draw upon this letter of credit, at any time and from time to time, by delivering a Letter of Credit Notice, substantially in the form set forth below ("Notice"), which Notice shall specify the amount (the "Draw Amount") to be drawn and the account (the "Bank Account") to which the Draw Amount should be delivered and shall be signed by an official designated and duly authorized by the Authority, to Lender at the address listed below, or to such other address as the Lender shall notify the Authority in writing by certified mail. Promptly after the delivery of each Notice, the Lender hereby covenants and agrees to deliver, by wire transfer of immediately available funds, the Draw Amount to the Bank Account.

This letter of credit shall be deemed automatically renewed without amendment for successive one-year periods and may be canceled by the Lender by giving (30) days advanced written notice by certified mall of such cancellation to the Authority and the Company, it being understood that the Lender shall not be relieved of liability that may have accrued under this letter of credit prior to the date of cancellation.

Pallure to renew this letter of credit shall allow the Authority to draw upon it without the necessity of the Authority being required to hold a hearing concerning the Principal's operation or Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity. In such an event and upon a directive from the Authority, the Lender hereby covenants and agrees to deliver by wire transfer of immediately available funds the maximum sum of this letter of credit to the Bank Account to enable the continued operation of the public wastewater utility.

The Lender Hereby represents and warrants that it is qualified and authorized to issue this letter of credit and is a bank designated by the Treasurer of the State of Tennessee as an authorized depository bank for the deposit of state funds.
