
ORDER APPROVING AMENDMENT
TO THE INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT

This matter came before Chairman Tre Hargett, Director Eddie Roberson and Director Mary W. Freeman of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on October 6, 2008 to consider the Petition for approval of the Amendment to the Interconnection Agreement negotiated between BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Tennessee¹ and MCImetro Access Transmission Services, LLC² filed on September 5, 2008.³

Based upon a review of the amendment, the record in this matter, and the standards for review set forth in 47 U.S.C. § 252, the Directors made findings consistent with those in the *Order Approving the Interconnection Agreement* issued on February 1, 2007 in Docket No. 06-00287 and unanimously granted the Petition.

² A name change to MCImetro Access Transmission Services, LLC d/b/a Verizon Access Transmission Services was approved by the Authority on March 20, 2006 in Docket No. 06-00040. The Petition referred to the company as MCImetro Access Transmission Services LLC.
