This will serve as notice as required by T.C.A. § 7-59-309(a)(1) on behalf of the Town of Farragut that it has received a notification from Charter Communications Operating, LLC that it has applied for a state-issued certificate to operate its cable system in the Town of Farragut, and that the Town of Farragut has one dedicated access channel for governmental use by the Town provided by the service provider with the most subscribers in the Town. The franchise agreement provides for only governmental access to this channel and there is no public or educational programming beyond information provided about the Town's operation or projects.

The franchise agreement also provides that the provider will make available without charge to all public educational institutions and governmental buildings within its service area and within 150 feet of the provider's existing distribution cable, one service outlet, which the institutions will be entitled to receive the basic cable television service free of charge.
