On January 24, 2012, the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA") received your application on behalf of Charter Communications, LLC ("Charter") to issue a first amendment to Charter's state-issued certificate of franchise authority pursuant to the Competitive Cable and Video Services Act ("CCVSA").<sup>1</sup> On January 27, 2012 the TRA received a correction revising the areas to include Neva, Crackers Neck and Laurel Bloomery and exclude Mountain City and Butler, which had been included in Charter's original state franchise.

Upon review, it has been determined that the revised application complies with the statutory requirements of the CCVSA and is therefore complete. Further action will be taken on the application as delineated within the CCVSA.
