SECOND AMENDMENT TO CHARTER COMMUNICATIONS OPERATING LLC'S CERTIFICATE OF FRANCHISE AUTHORITY

Pursuant to the Competitive Cable and Video Services Act, Charter

Communications Operating LLC ("Charter") seeks to amend its Certificate of Franchise

Authority. In support of this request, Charter states as follows:

- 1. The Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA") granted Charter a Certificate of Franchise on October 7, 2008.
- 2. On January 13, 2012, Charter filed its First Amendment to its Certificate of Franchise Authority, which the TRA granted on February 21, 2012.
- 3. Charter now seeks to amend its Certificate of Franchise Authority to assign franchises that are currently held by wholly owned Charter subsidiaries Marcus Cable Associates ("MCA"), Rifken Acquisition Partners ("RAP"), Charter Communications, LLC ("CC LLC"), HPI Acquisition Co. ("HPIAC"), and Renaissance Media, LLC ("RML"), to another wholly-owned Charter subsidiary, Interlink Communications Partners, LLC ("ICP").
- 4. The franchises currently held by Robin Media Group ("Robin"), and ICP will continue to be held by those entities.

- 5. Bluff City, currently held by Tennessee, LLC ("TN LLC"), will be assigned to ICP. All other franchises held by TN LLC will remain with TN LLC.
- 6. Charter has provided a copy of this Amendment to the local units of government affected by this Amendment.
 - 7. Charter has enclosed the required fee of \$250 with this Amendment.
