THIRD AMENDED CERTIFICATE OF FRANCHISE AUTHORITY

On May 11, 2016, pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 7-59-301, *et seq.*, also known as the Competitive Cable and Video Services Act (“CCVSA”), Charter Communications Operating, LLC (“Charter”) filed a Third Amendment to its Certificate of Franchise Authority. In its Third Amendment, Charter assigns franchises currently held by wholly owned Charter subsidiaries Robin Media Group (“Robin”) and Tennessee, LLC (“TN LLC”) to another wholly owned Charter subsidiary, Interlink Communications Partners, LLC (“ICP”). The franchises currently being held by ICP will continue to be held by that entity. Upon such filing, the Tennessee Regulatory Authority hereby issues the Third Amended Certificate of Franchise Authority to supplement Charter’s original Certificate of Franchise Authority and its previous amendments thereto.¹
