FIFTH AMENDED CERTIFICATE OF FRANCHISE AUTHORITY

On August 7, 2017, pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 7-59-301, *et seq.*, also known as the Competitive Cable and Video Services Act ("CCVSA"), Charter Communications Operating, LLC ("Charter") filed with the Tennessee Public Utility Commission ("TPUC") a *Fifth Amendment to Certificate of Franchise Authority*. In its Fifth Amendment, Charter includes areas that are currently served by Time Warner Cable Midwest LLC, an indirect, wholly-owned subsidiary of Charter. Upon such filing, the Tennessee Public Utility Commission hereby issues the *Fifth Amended Certificate of Franchise Authority* to supplement Charter's original *Certificate of Franchise Authority* issued October 7, 2008 and its previous amendments thereto.¹
