EIGHTH AMENDED CERTIFICATE OF FRANCHISE AUTHORITY

On February 2, 2022, pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 7-59-301, *et seq.*, also known as the Competitive Cable and Video Services Act (“CCVSA”), Charter Communications Operating, LLC, now known as Spectrum Southeast, LLC (“Spectrum”),¹ filed with the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (“TPUC”) a *Eighth Amendment to Certificate of Franchise Authority*. In its Eighth Amendment, Spectrum includes service areas listed on Aurora Cable TV Company’s (d/b/a Benton County Cable System) Certificate of Franchise Authority² and purchased by Spectrum on January 31, 2022. Upon such filing, the Tennessee Public Utility Commission hereby issues the *Eighth Amended Certificate of Franchise Authority* to supplement Spectrum’s original *Certificate of Franchise Authority* issued October 7, 2008 and its previous amendments thereto.
