NINTH AMENDED CERTIFICATE OF FRANCHISE AUTHORITY

On June 23, 2022, pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 7-59-301, *et seq.*, also known as the Competitive Cable and Video Services Act ("CCVSA"), Charter Communications Operating, LLC, now known as Spectrum Southeast, LLC ("Spectrum"),¹ filed with the Tennessee Public Utility Commission ("TPUC") a *Ninth Amendment to Certificate of Franchise Authority*. In its Ninth Amendment, Spectrum includes the following service areas. The unincorporated areas of Anderson, Dickson, Greene, Polk, Unicoi, and Union Counties; the Towns of Burns, Charlotte, Eastview, Guys, Hickory Valley, Hornsby, Stantonville, Spring City, and Vonore; as well as the Cities of Athens, Blaine, Copper Hill, Crab Orchard, Ducktown, Etowah, Friendsville, Greenback, Harriman, La Follette, Maynardville, Parkers Crossroads, Plainview, Rockford, Rockwood, and Soddy-Daisy. Upon such filing, the Tennessee Public Utility Commission hereby issues the *Ninth Amended Certificate of Franchise Authority* to supplement Spectrum's original *Certificate of Franchise Authority* issued October 7, 2008, and its previous amendments thereto.
