TENTH AMENDED CERTIFICATE OF FRANCHISE AUTHORITY

On February 3, 2023, pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 7-59-301, *et seq.*, also known as the Competitive Cable and Video Services Act (“CCVSA”), Charter Communications Operating, LLC, now known as Spectrum Southeast, LLC (“Spectrum”),¹ filed with the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (“C0mmission”) a *Tenth Amendment to Certificate of Franchise Authority*. In its Tenth Amendment, Spectrum includes the following service areas. The unincorporated areas of Humphries County and the City of Waverly. Additionally, on February 10, 2023, Charter acquired InfoStructure, Inc’s (d/b/a Clickone.net) cable assets in Tennessee. Upon such filing, the Tennessee Public Utility Commission hereby transfers, to Spectrum, the service areas listed on the Certificate² issued in Docket No. 14-00058, terminates the Certificate issued in that docket and issues the *Tenth Amended Certificate of Franchise Authority* to supplement Spectrum’s original *Certificate of Franchise Authority* issued October 7, 2008, and its previous amendments thereto.
