ELEVENTH AMENDED CERTIFICATE OF FRANCHISE AUTHORITY

On March 12, 2024, pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 7-59-301, *et seq.*, also known as the Competitive Cable and Video Services Act (“CCVSA”), Charter Communications Operating, LLC, now known as Spectrum Southeast, LLC (“Spectrum”),¹ filed with the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (“TPUC”) an *Eleventh Amendment to its Certificate of Franchise Authority*. In its Eleventh Amendment, Spectrum includes the following service areas. The Cities of Finger, Middleton, Niota, and Philadelphia as well as the Towns of Michie, Silerton and Stantonville. Additionally, on April 15, 2023, Charter acquired the Tennessee assets of Pickwick Cablevision, Inc. Upon such filing, the Tennessee Public Utility Commission hereby transfers, to Spectrum, the service areas listed on the Certificate² issued in Docket No. 22-00145, terminates the Certificate issued in that docket and issues the *Eleventh Amended Certificate of Franchise Authority* to supplement Spectrum’s original *Certificate of Franchise Authority* issued October 7, 2008, and renewed on October 25, 2018, as well as its previous amendments thereto.
