TWELFTH AMENDED CERTIFICATE OF FRANCHISE AUTHORITY

On August 29, 2024, pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 7-59-301, *et seq.*, also known as the Competitive Cable and Video Services Act (“CCVSA”), Charter Communications Operating, LLC, now known as Spectrum Southeast, LLC (“Spectrum”),¹ filed with the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (“TPUC”) a *Twelfth Amendment to its Certificate of Franchise Authority*. In its Twelfth Amendment, Spectrum includes the following service area. The Town of Pittman Center. Additionally, on August 30, 2023, Charter acquired the Tennessee assets of Spring City Cable TV, Inc. Upon such filing, the Tennessee Public Utility Commission hereby transfers, to Spectrum, the service area listed on the Certificate in Docket No. 11-00146, terminates the Certificate issued in that docket and issues the *Twelfth Amended Certificate of Franchise Authority* to supplement Spectrum’s original *Certificate of Franchise Authority* issued October 7, 2008, and renewed on October 25, 2018, as well as its previous amendments thereto.
