Response of Global Crossing Telecommunications, Inc. Docket 08-00191

1. Have the applicants filed similar applications or notices in other states? If so, provide a listing of states and action taken.

The company has filed or plans to file application or notices in all states where required. States vary on how companies must notify the Commission of proposed mergers. Some states require that the Company file information prior to the anticipated merger while others want notification after the merger has been consummated. Attachment I to this filing provides a brief overview of the status of the merger filings in all states.

2. Given the description of the transaction in the Notice, indicate whether FCC approval is required for any portion of the transaction. If so, have the applicants filed an application or notice with the FCC? If so, list any action taken and the associated docket number. If a schedule to complete the review of the application has been established by the FCC, provide such with your response.

The FCC does not require prior approval for internal corporate reorganizations per Section 63.03 and 63.24 of the Commission's Rules (C.F.R. 47 §63.03 and §63.24). A pro forma filing will be made with the Commission within 30 days of the consummation of the merger.

3. Verify that Global Crossing Telecommunications, Inc. will provide service only within the confines of its existing certification as a reseller of interexchange telecommunications services after the merger.

After the merger, the Global Crossing Telecommunications, Inc. wants to assume the full scope of authority now granted to Global Crossing North American Networks, Inc. As stated in the filing: "After the closing of this transaction, GC Telecommunications will obtain control over the intrastate facilities previously owned by GC North American. Accordingly, it requests that its certificate, issued in Docket U-84-7325, be modified to include permission to provide the same facilities-based interexchange long distance service as GC North American. Since, as described above, the network assets of GC North American will be transferred to GC Telecommunications, including personnel necessary to operate those facilities."

4. Indicate whether Global Crossing North American Networks, Inc. currently owns and operates network facilities in Tennessee.

GC North American currently holds an indefeasible right of use in a fiber optic cable that is owned by Qwest Communications and runs over a railroad right of way in Tennessee. There are two points of presence and two amplifier sites in Tennessee where Global Crossing leases facilities from Qwest as part of the operation of the cable.

5. Provide a copy of the merger agreement between Global Crossing Telecommunications, Inc. and Global Crossing North American Networks, Inc.

This is an internal corporate reorganization only. No merger agreement has been created. Only Secretary of State filings canceling Global Crossing North American Networks, Inc. and updating Budget Call Long Distance, Inc.'s ownership will be prepared. All other changes will be internal bookkeeping entries.

6. Discuss whether the requested merger is in the public interest.

This merger is an internal corporate restructuring only, with no effect on customers' rates, terms or conditions of service. The merger will serve to reduce costs and increase efficiencies for the Global Crossing entities, thus helping the remaining Global Crossing Telecommunications, Inc. entity compete more effectively in the market.
