

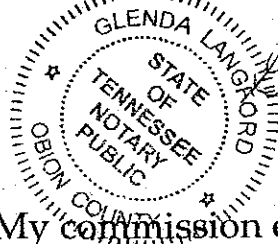

Notice is hereby given that Atmos Energy Corporation (the Company) filed a Petition with the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (TRA) on October 15, 2008 in Docket No. 08-00197, proposing to change rates for natural gas service now in effect. The rates proposed by the Company are subject to approval by the TRA. The TRA may adopt, reject, increase or decrease any of the proposed rates in part or in whole. A complete copy of the proposed rate changes and the reasons for them are on file with the TRA and for public inspection. The Company has requested this change in rates in order to permit it an opportunity to recover its reasonable operating costs and to earn a fair and reasonable return on its investment. The predicted impact of the proposed changes on the average residential customer is an increase of approximately \$29 per year. The predicted impact of the proposed changes on the average small commercial class customer is an increase of approximately \$133 per year. The predicted impact on remaining customers is an increase of approximately 3.9% on their total annual bill. The matter is set for hearing on March 9, 2009, beginning at 9:00 a.m. in the TRA's Hearing Room on the Grounds at 460 James Robertson Parkway, Nashville, Tennessee. The Company's current and proposed rates are as follows and do not include gas cost that is recovered through the Purchased Gas Adjustment.
