Status Conference (immediately following 1:00 p.m. Authority Conference); parties should be prepared to respond to any objections¹ to the first round of discovery requests

November 26, 2008

Response to first round of discovery requests

The remaining procedural schedule will be discussed and set at the November 10th Status Conference.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

- 1. The *Petition to Intervene* filed on October 17, 2008 by the Consumer Advocate is granted. The Consumer Advocate may participate in this proceeding as its interests require and receive copies of any notices, orders or other documents filed herein.
 - 2. A preliminary procedural schedule is established as stated herein.
- 3. All filings are due no later than **2:00 p.m**. on the dates indicated in the preliminary procedural schedule. One copy of all discovery requests, objections and responses shall be filed with the Authority.
