
ORDER GRANTING APPROVAL OF NAME CHANGE

This matter came before Chairman Eddie Roberson, Director Sara Kyle, and Director Mary W. Freeman of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on January 26, 2009, upon the petition of Qwest Communications Corporation ("QCC" or "Company") to change its name.

QCC was granted authority to resell interexchange long distance telecommunications services in Tennessee by the Tennessee Public Service Commission in Docket No. 95-03130 at a Commission Conference held on September 19, 1995. In an Order dated March 22, 2001 in Docket No. 99-00922, QCC was also granted authority to provide competitive local exchange services in Tennessee. In Docket No. 05-00019, QCC was granted authority to amend its certificate of convenience and necessity to provide local telecommunications services to allow QCC to offer facilities-based interexchange telecommunications services. On October 17, 2008, QCC filed a Petition to change its name to Qwest Communications Company, LLC.

Based upon careful consideration of the record of this matter and upon a finding that the Company has satisfied the requirements of Tenn. Comp. R. & Regs. 1220-4-1-.08, the panel unanimously voted to approve the name change.


