## CONSUMER ADVOCATE'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE TESTIMONY

Robert E. Cooper, Jr., Attorney General and Reporter for the State of Tennessee, by and through the Consumer Advocate and Protection Division of the Office of the Attorney General ("Consumer Advocate"), hereby moves for an extension of time in which to file its testimony in this case until Friday, April 17, 2009.

According to the procedural schedule set by the Hearing Officer, the Consumer Advocate's testimony was due on April 6, 2009. However, by letter from counsel for Tennessee Wastewater dated March 18, 2009, Tennessee Wastewater gave the Consumer Advocate three additional days to file its testimony because Tennessee Wastewater had extended the time it took to file the discovery responses necessary for drafting testimony by three days. Thus, the Consumer Advocate's testimony is currently due on Thursday, April 9, 2009. At this time no hearing date has been announced.

On Tuesday, April 7, 2009, the Company and the Consumer Advocate met in order to discuss certain information provided by the Company to the Consumer Advocate. The meeting was productive and again on Wednesday, April 8, 2009, the Company sent the Consumer Advocate additional information. The Consumer Advocate would like to consider this

information before filing its testimony but in order to do so, it needs additional time, especially in light of the fact that Friday, April 10, 2009 is a holiday.

Accordingly, the Consumer Advocate moves for additional time until Friday, April 17, 2009, to file its testimony. The Company is in agreement with the extension of time.
