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
**ORDER SUSPENDING TARIFF FOR NINETY DAYS,  
CONVENING A CONTESTED CASE AND  
APPOINTING A HEARING OFFICER**


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This matter came before Director Eddie Roberson, Director Sara Kyle and Director Mary W. Freeman of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on November 10, 2008 for consideration of the *Petition of Tennessee Wastewater Systems, Inc. to Change and Increase Certain Rates and Charges* filed on October 20, 2008 requesting approval of a revised tariff with an effective date of December 1, 2008. King's Chapel Capacity, LLC and the Consumer Advocate and Protection Division of the Office of the Attorney General filed petitions to intervene on October 24, 2008 and November 3, 2008, respectively. During the Authority Conference, the panel voted unanimously to suspend the proposed tariff for ninety days, from December 1, 2008 to March 1, 2009, to convene a contested case proceeding and to appoint the Authority's General Counsel or his designee to serve as Hearing Officer for the purpose of hearing preliminary matters, including ruling on petitions to intervene, setting a procedural schedule to completion and preparing the matter for a hearing before the panel.
