**PETITION OF BEN LOMAND COMMUNICATIONS, LLC TO MODIFY ITS
CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY**

Ben Lomand Communications, LLC ("BLC" or "Petitioner"), by its undersigned counsel, and pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-2-103 and 65-4-201 through 65-4-204 and Tenn. Comp. R. & Regs. 1220-4-8-.02 through 1220-4-8-.04 hereby respectfully requests the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA" or "Authority"), to modify its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity for authority to provide telecommunications services on a statewide basis.

The relief requested herein will provide significant benefits to Tennessee telecommunications consumers in terms of increased carrier choices, competitive pricing, increased reliability, responsiveness, and the introduction of new and innovative services. It will also stimulate investment in Tennessee's telecommunications infrastructure, resulting in economic development.

In support of this Petition, BLC provides the following information:

I. PETITIONER

A. Corporate Information: BLC, a wholly owned subsidiary of Ben Lomand Rural Telephone Cooperative, is a diversified telecommunications company, duly certified to do

business in the State of Tennessee by the Authority through the grant of a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") by Order, dated April 28, 1999 (Docket No. 98-00600). Such CCN is limited to the counties of Warren and White. BLC is the successor-in-interest to Ben Lomand Communications, Inc. by Order dated January 17, 2008 (Docket No. 07-00255).

C. Corporate Structure: An organizational chart of corporate structure is provided in **Exhibit A**. The Articles of Organization are provided in **Exhibit B**.

D. Officers: Profiles of the key management staff of BLC are provided in **Exhibit C**. Such staff hold the same positions in BLC as in its parent company, Ben Lomand Rural Telephone Cooperative, Inc.

II. QUALIFICATIONS

BLC possesses the managerial, technical and financial ability to provide local telecommunications services statewide as demonstrated below:

A. Managerial & Technical Qualifications: The Authority granted BLC its current CCN based in part upon finding that BLC possessed the requisite managerial and technical qualifications to provide telecommunications services in Tennessee, including services as a CLEC. Since the grant of that CCN, BLC has maintained its senior managers, as listed in Exhibit C. Together, BLC's officers have decades of experience in the telecommunications industry which provides the technical expertise to execute the company's business plan, to provide its proposed telecommunications services, and to operate and maintain BLC's facilities. BLC remains managerially and technically qualified to provide telecommunications services throughout the State of Tennessee.

B. Financial Qualifications: The Authority granted BLC its current CCN based in part upon finding that BLC possessed the requisite financial qualifications to provide telecommunications services in Tennessee. Since the grant of its certificate, BLC has remained profitable and maintained access to working capital necessary to fund its in-state operations.

Financial information relating to BLC is provided in **Exhibit D** which is **CONFIDENTIAL AND PROPRIETARY**. Such financial information consists of audited financial statements for Fiscal Years ending September 30, 2004-2007. Unaudited financials are provided for 2008 through September 30.

BLC's financials do not reflect any revenues or expenses associated with reciprocal compensation.

III. PROPOSED SERVICES

A. Description of Proposed Services: BLC currently provides all residential and business services authorized by its CCN, and diversified telecommunications services including but not limited to toll, local exchange, access, private line, voicemail, broadband, and vertical features. BLC will offer such services in the proposed service area, including broadband where it is not presently available in the proposed service area.

B. Description of Additional Service Area: As set forth in the introduction, BLC is requesting authority to provide services statewide. Initially, BLC will offer services contiguous to, and in close proximity with, its present service area of Warren and White Counties.

C. Description of Proposed Facilities: BLC intends to build its own facilities and lease facilities as appropriate.

IV. DESCRIPTION OF REGULATORY OBLIGATIONS AND COMMITMENTS

A. BLC anticipates a need for an NXX code or possibly a one-thousand block(s) of numbers in each rate center in which it decides to provision CLEC service. Those plans are not finalized therefore the specific number of codes or locations are not available at this time.

B. BLC is familiar with and will adhere to all applicable Authority rules, policies and orders governing the provisions of local exchange telecommunications services in the State of Tennessee, including those set forth in Rule 1220-4-8-.04(3).

C. BLC submits a Small and Minority Owned Telecommunications Business Participation Plan annually with the TRA. BLC will adhere to its most current Small and Minority Owned Telecommunications Business Participation Plan on file with the Authority.

D. In compliance with the Authority's rules, BLC shall either directly or through other arrangements, provide the directory, blocking, support, interconnection and other services mandated by the Authority as required and applicable.

E. Customers with service, billing and repair questions, and complaints may reach BLC twenty-four (24) hours per day, seven (7) days per week using the following toll-free customer service number: 1-800-522-2955. Inquiries about customer service issues may be directed to:

F. BLC will handle repair and maintenance in Tennessee as follows: BLC's customers may call the toll-free number above to report service problems requiring repair or maintenance. BLC will respond to repair and maintenance calls promptly and, where necessary, dispatch a service technician or otherwise respond to the service ticket as soon as possible. Because customer satisfaction is extremely important to BLC and to its success in the competitive marketplace, all commercially reasonable efforts will be made to address and resolve customer concerns as quickly as possible.

G. BLC does not collect deposits from first time customers. If a returning customer has a previously unpaid bill, BLC collects a nominal deposit based on the unpaid balance. To the extent that BLC does collect deposits, BLC will comply with the Authority's applicable rules and regulations.

H. BLC will file tariff revisions, to the extent that it is necessary, subsequent to approval of its application and prior to providing service in those areas of Tennessee covered by this Petition.

I. BLC's internal policies regarding changes of local and long distance carriers will be consistent with applicable Federal Communication Commission ("FCC") telemarketing and carrier change rules, and will comply with any applicable Tennessee policies, rules, and orders governing such carrier changes.

J. BLC is aware of the telemarketing statutes and regulations found in Sections 65-4-401 through Sections 65-4-408 of the Tennessee Code Annotated and in Chapter 1220-4-11 of the Authority's Rules and Regulations and will comply with such rules if and when it uses telemarketing in Tennessee.

K. Pre-filed Testimony is provided as **Exhibit E**.


VI. PUBLIC INTEREST STATEMENT

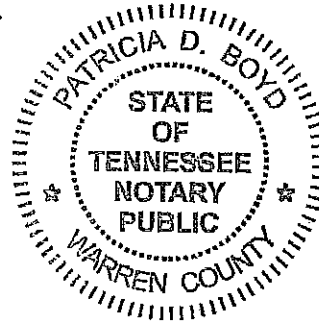

CORPORATE STRUCTURE

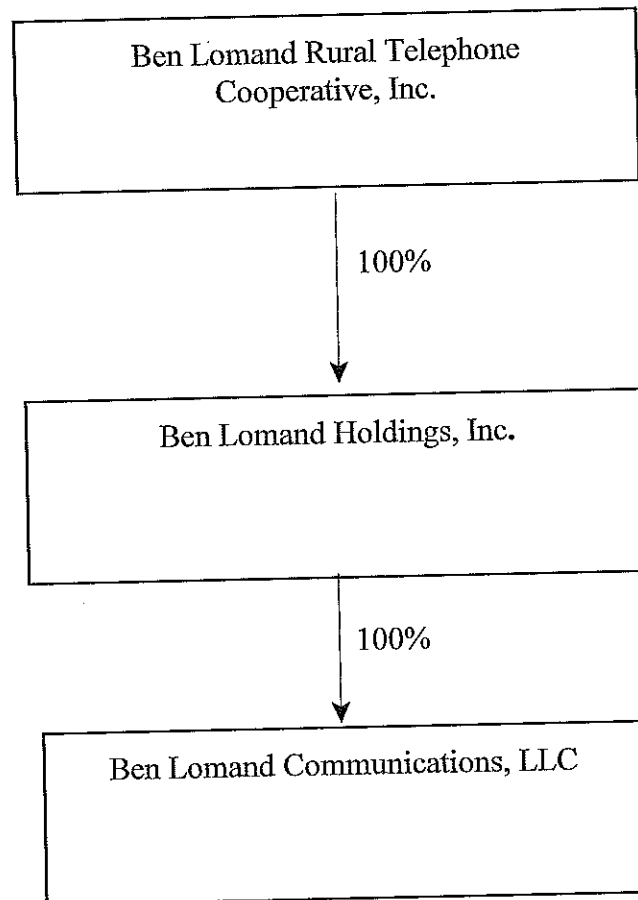

PRE-FILED TESTIMONY OF LEVOY KNOWLES

I, Levoy Knowles, do hereby testify as follows in support of the Petition of Ben Lomand Communications, LLC ("BLC") To Modify Its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity.

Q: Please state your full name, business address, and position.

A: My name is Levoy Knowles. I am BLC's Chief Manager. My business address is Ben Lomand Communications, LLC, 311 N. Chancery Street, McMinnville, Tennessee 37110.

Q: Please briefly describe your duties.

A: As Chief Manager, I am responsible for the oversight of the day to day operations of BLC. This includes business development, budgeting, and approval and oversight of network upgrades.

Q: Please describe your business experience and educational background.

A: I am a 1976 graduate of Tennessee Technological University. I received my Bachelor of Science Degree in Business Management with an emphasis in Accounting. I later earned my CPA certificate in 1980 after working for three years in industry and another three years with a local public accounting firm. I joined Ben Lomand Telephone Cooperative on December 1, 1981, as an accountant. Over the next few years, I was promoted to Assistant Manager and then General Manager on January 1, 1989. My title was later changed to CEO in 1999. Ben Lomand Communications is a wholly owned subsidiary of the Co-op and was formed in 1993 to provide long distance service. It was later expanded to become a CLEC in 1998 after the passage of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 allowed competition. I have served as the Executive Vice President and/or Chief Manager of BLC since its inception. I participate in several professional and industry associations. I am a member of the AICPA, the Tennessee Society of CPA's, and the Upper Cumberland Chapter of CPA's. I am serving or have served in several leadership roles in national trade associations such as the United States Telecom Association (USTA), the Rural Independent Competitive Alliance (RICA) and have previously served on the Board and Past President of the Tennessee Telecom Association.

Q: Are all statements in BLC's Petition true and correct to the best of your knowledge, information and belief?

A: Yes.

Q: Please describe the current corporate structure of BLC.

A: BLC is a limited liability corporation and the corporate structure of BLC is depicted in Exhibit B of the petition.

Q: Does BLC possess the requisite managerial, financial, and technical abilities to provide the services for which it has applied for authority?

A: Yes. BLC possesses the requisite managerial, financial, and technical abilities to provide the services for which it has applied for authority. The Authority granted BLC its current CCN based in part upon finding that BLC possessed the requisite managerial and technical qualifications to provide telecommunications services in Tennessee, including services as a CLEC. Since the grant of that CCN, BLC has maintained its senior managers, as listed in Exhibit C of the petition. Together, BLC's officers have decades of experience in the telecommunications industry which provides the technical expertise to execute the company's business plan, to provide its proposed telecommunications services, and to operate and maintain BLC's facilities. BLC remains managerially and technically qualified to provide telecommunications services throughout the State of Tennessee.

Q: Please describe BLC's financial qualifications.

A: BLC has access to the financing and capital necessary to conduct its telecommunications operations as specified in its Petition. The Authority granted BLC its current CCN based in part upon finding that BLC possessed the requisite financial qualifications to provide telecommunications services in Tennessee. Since the grant of its certificate, BLC has remained profitable and maintained access to working capital necessary to fund its in-state operations. Financial information relating to BLC is provided in Exhibit D of the petition which is CONFIDENTIAL AND PROPRIETARY. BLC's financials do not reflect any revenues or expenses associated with reciprocal compensation.

Q: What services will BLC offer?

A: BLC will continue to offer all services presently provided by BLC, including services not presently offered in the proposed service area, such as broadband.

Q: What is the proposed additional service area?

A: BLC is requesting statewide service. However, initially BLC will offer services contiguous to, and compatible with, its present service area of Warren and White counties.

Q: Will BLC offer service to all consumers within its service area?

A: Yes.

Q: Will the granting of a certificate of convenience and necessity to BLC serve the public interest?

A: Yes. The granting of a certificate of convenience and necessity will serve the public interest because it will increase competition in the market for telecommunications services in the Tennessee, leading to downward pressure on prices and more innovative service offerings. BLC's proposed service offerings are based on the concept of bringing technologically advanced services to a broader base of Tennessee customers.

Q: Has BLC or one of its affiliates ever been investigated or sanctioned by any regulatory authority for service or billing irregularities?

A: No.
