Dear Mr. Hyatt:

This letter is to inform you the Division of Water Resources (the division) is administratively inactivating the file record the above referenced permit for the following reasons:

- The above referenced SOP expired on 30-NOV-13. The division mailed a warning letter on 22-JUL-14, regarding the application deadline for a permit renewal. To date we have not received this application from your company;
- The division never received evidence of ownership of the treatment facility land application site(s) and/or a copy of the perpetual easement(s) as required by the permit; and
- The division has not approved plans and specifications for construction of a sewage treatment system;
- A sewerage treatment system has neither been constructed nor provided to your utility for use in providing utility service.

This administrative inactiviation of the file record will become effective from 30days from the date of this letter.
