
ORDER GRANTING APPROVAL OF NAME CHANGE

This matter came before Chairman Eddie Roberson, Director Sara Kyle, and Director Mary W. Freeman of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on March 30, 2009, upon the petition of CommuniGroup of Jackson, Inc. ("CGJ" or "Company") to change its name.


CGJ was granted authority to provide competing telecommunications service and exchange access services within the State of Tennessee in Docket No. 03-00172. CGJ was also granted a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to resell interexchange telecommunications services in Tennessee by Order in Docket No. 95-02751. On February 24, 2009, CGJ filed a Petition to change its name to TEC of Jackson, Inc.

Based upon careful consideration of the record of this matter and upon a finding that the Company has satisfied the requirements of Tenn. Comp. R. & Regs. 1220-4-1-.08, the panel unanimously voted to approve the name change.
