MOTION TO FILE SUPPLEMENTAL TESTIMONY

The Consumer Advocate and Protection Division of the Tennessee Attorney General and Reporter ("Consumer Advocate") herein requests the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA, Authority") to accept supplemental direct testimony by Mr. David Peters on behalf of the Consumer Advocate. The supplemental testimony corrects errors in Mr. Peter's Direct Testimony filed on June 19, 2009 and incorporates information gathered from supplemental discovery responses submitted by Lynwood. The supplemental testimony substantially changes the position of the Consumer Advocate to the extent it raises the appropriate rate increase from a level of a 7.96% proposed in the June 19, 2009 testimony to an increase of 12.69% as proposed in the supplemental testimony. Thus, the supplemental testimony narrows the amount of the rate increase in controversy.


