I am writing to provide the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA") with the additional information requested by Paul Green during the Friday, August 21, 2009, hearing in the above referenced Docket. Specifically, Mr. Green requested a detailed description of how the Consumer Advocate calculated the proper amount of Accumulated Depreciation in this matter. A more thorough explanation is provided below:

The company proposed a number of \$121,569 (Sched. 2) and our number was \$114,803. Our number was derived from the following components;

- Depreciation expense from Company Schedule E-6 \$157,214
- Amortization of CIAC from Company Schedule E-6 (\$50,824)
- CAPD removing 2008 depreciation expense for 2008 Collection System Company Schedule B-3 \$8,413
