**ORDER SUSPENDING TARIFF FOR NINETY DAYS
AND APPOINTING A HEARING OFFICER**

This matter came before Chairman Eddie Roberson, Director Sara Kyle and Director Mary W. Freeman of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on March 30, 2009 for consideration of the Petition of Lynwood Utility Corporation to change and increase rates and charges filed on March 5, 2009 requesting approval of a revised tariff with an effective date of April 4, 2009. A petition to intervene was filed by the Consumer Advocate and Protection Division of the Office of the Attorney General on March 18, 2009. During the Authority Conference, the panel voted unanimously to suspend the proposed tariff for ninety days, from April 4, 2009 to July 3, 2009, and to appoint the Authority's General Counsel or his designee to serve as Hearing Officer for the purpose of hearing preliminary matters, including entering a protective order and ruling on petitions to intervene, setting a procedural schedule to completion and preparing the matter for a hearing before the panel.
