
1. Has construction begun on any portion of the wastewater system, treatment or collection system? If so, please indicate how much has been completed and how long until the system will be finished.
2. Have any lots been sold in the Peninsula Development? If any lots have been sold, has attestation been given stating that wastewater services would be available? Who signed the attestation?
3. Has construction of homes been started on any lots?
4. Please provide a signed copy of the contract between Aqua Green Utility, Inc. and the Developer, The Peninsula on Douglass Lake, LLC, or other Developer.
5. Has an operating permit application been filed with The Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation ("TDEC")? If yes, please provide the date the application was filed and the current status of that application? If not, provide an explanation as to why it has not been filed.

Please provide your responses no later than 2:00 P.M. on Wednesday May 27, 2009 and reference Docket No. 09-00045. In accordance with TRA rules, submit either one original

and thirteen (13) written copies of your response or an original and four (4) written copies and an electronic version.
