IN RE: *Appropriateness of Implementation of PURPA Standard 16 (Integrated Resource Planning) and Standard 17 (Rate Design Modification) for Kingsport Power Company d/b/a AEP Appalachian Power*

DATE: July 27, 2009

At a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on May 18, 2009, pursuant to the Public Utility Regulatory Policies Act of 1978 ("PURPA"), as amended by the Energy Independence and Security Act of 2007, the panel voted unanimously to open a docket for the purpose of considering and determining the appropriateness of implementation of the standards contained in 16 U.S.C. § 2621(d)(16) through (17) as they relate to Kingsport Power. The panel further voted to appoint the Authority's General Counsel or his designee for the purpose of hearing preliminary matters and preparing the matter for a hearing before the panel.

On June 3, 2009, the Hearing Officer assigned to this docket held a Status Conference for the purposes of reviewing and determining the issues, and setting a procedural schedule. During the Status Conference, Kingsport Power agreed to file comments explaining its position related to the federal standards no later than **2:00 p.m. on Monday, August 3, 2009.**
