Pursuant to the request of Jerry Kettles of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority staff, Charter Fiberlink - Tennessee, LLC (“Charter Fiberlink”) hereby provides the following responses to Data Request No. 1 in connection with the above-referenced Application. The numbered paragraphs below correspond to the individual data requests.

1. Has the Petitioner filed similar petitions or notices in other states? If so, provide a listing of states and action taken.

Charter Fiberlink only operates in the State of Tennessee. As such, Charter Fiberlink has not filed a similar petition or notice in any other state.

However, affiliates of Charter Fiberlink that provide communications services have filed similar petitions or notices in the following states: Alabama, Arkansas, California, Connecticut, Georgia, Idaho, Illinois, Kansas, Louisiana, Massachusetts, Michigan, Minnesota, Mississippi, Missouri, Nebraska, North Carolina, New Hampshire, New Mexico, New York, Nevada, Ohio, Oklahoma, Oregon, South Carolina, Texas, Virginia, Washington, and Wisconsin. Such petitions or notices are pending in California, Louisiana, Mississippi, Minnesota, New York, Texas, and Virginia. In the other states, the state commissions have either disclaimed jurisdiction to review the reorganization transaction or Charter Fiberlink’s affiliates have confirmed that no approval is required to engage in the reorganization transaction.

- 2. Has the Petitioner filed a similar petition with the FCC? If so, list any action taken and the associated docket number. If a schedule to complete the review of your application has been established by the FCC, provide with your response.**

Charter Communications, Inc. ("Charter") filed a combined domestic and international Section 214 Application with the FCC on behalf of its telephone subsidiaries, including Charter Fiberlink, for authority to engage in the reorganization transaction and to emerge from bankruptcy. The application is currently pending in MB Docket No. 09-77. The FCC released a Public Notice with respect to Charter's application on May 21, 2009. Petitions to Deny/Comments regarding the application are due by June 22, 2009 and Oppositions/Reply Comments are due by July 7, 2009.
