Fourth Amendment to Interconnection Agreement

The Interconnection Agreement dated as of June 13, 2003 between Concord Telephone Exchange, Inc., Tennessee Telephone Company, Humphreys County Telephone Company, and Tellico Telephone Company, Inc. (collectively "TDS TELECOM") and US LEC of Tennessee Inc., d/b/a PAETEC Business Services ("PAETEC") filed with the Tennessee Regulatory Authority in Docket 03-00415 on June 23, 2003 is hereby amended as follows:

NIM-1st amended Exhibit A-1

Effective May 15, 2009

Pursuant to Section 2.2.2 of Appendix NIM, Exhibit A-1 is amended to reflect the mutually agreed upon Point of Interconnection (POI) for two-way direct facilities between PAETEC and TDS TELECOM to be CNCRTNXADS2. V coordinate = 06839, H coordinate = 02273.

The Parties agree that a portion of the existing facilities between PAETEC and the Concord Telephone Exchange central office shall be dedicated for the two-way exchange of Local Traffic between PAETEC and TDS TELECOM. The Parties will share in the cost of these dedicated two-way facilities based upon each Party's relative use. Initial traffic studies suggest a traffic ratio of ninety (90) percent TDS TELECOM to PAETEC and ten (10) percent PAETEC to TDS TELECOM. PAETEC will issue an invoice monthly to TDS TELECOM for \$137.70 for each T1 utilized for the two-way traffic as agreed to between the Parties. This charge represents 90% of PAETEC's monthly cost of \$153.00 per T1. Each Party agrees to be responsible for any trunk and/or port facilities on their respective side of the POI.

The Parties also agree that should traffic studies indicate a material change in the relative use of the facilities from the above percentages for a consecutive three (3) month period; the Parties will renegotiate the percentage on a prospective basis.

The remaining terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain in effect.


