**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY  
TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES**

This matter came before Chairman James M. Allison, Director Kenneth C. Hill and Director Robin Bennett of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on May 5, 2014. iNetworks Group, Inc. ("iNetworks" or the "Company") originally filed an Application for authority to resell local and interexchange long distance telecommunications services in Tennessee on June 11, 2009. During a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on August 24, 2009, the Directors found that the Company had met all the requirements for certification and approved the Application.

On November 21, 2013, the Authority received a request from iNetworks to cancel its authority.<sup>1</sup> Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the Directors voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its authority.
