
ORDER APPROVING AMENDMENT
TO THE PAGING INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT


This matter came before Chairman Sara Kyle, Director Eddie Roberson and Director Mary W. Freeman of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on July 13, 2009 to consider the Petition for approval of the Amendment to the Paging Interconnection Agreement negotiated between BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Tennessee¹ and Metrocall, Inc.² filed on June 16, 2009.³

Based upon a review of the amendment, the record in this matter, and the standards for review set forth in 47 U.S.C. § 252, the Directors made findings consistent with those in the *Order Approving the Paging Interconnection Agreement* issued on January 4, 2006 in Docket No. 05-00280 and unanimously granted the Petition.
