## ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES

This matter came before Chairman Herbert H. Hilliard, Director Kenneth C. Hill and Director Robin Morrison of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority" or "TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on February 8, 2016. Tri-M Communications, Inc. d/b/a TMC Communications ("Tri-M") filed an Application for authority to resell interexchange long distance services in Tennessee on June 29, 2009. During a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on August 4, 2009, the Directors found that Tri-M had met all the requirements for certification and approved the Application. Tri-M notified the TRA of a name change to Globalinx Enterprises, Inc. ("Globalinx") on January 16, 2014, in Docket No. 14-00008. On October 26, 2015, the TRA received a request from Globalinx to cancel its authority, stating that it has no customers in Tennessee. Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the Directors voted unanimously to grant Globalinx's request to cancel its authority.
