**ORDER GRANTING REQUEST TO CANCEL AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE
TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES**

This matter came before Chairman David F. Jones, Vice Chairman Clay R. Good, Commissioner Herbert H. Hilliard, Commissioner Robin L. Morrison, and Commissioner Kenneth C. Hill of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (the “Commission” or “TPUC”), the voting panel assigned to this docket, during a regularly scheduled Commission Conference held on August 17, 2026. The panel convened to consider CBTS Technology Solutions LLC’s (“CBTS” or the “Company”) request to cancel its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (“CCN”) for competitive telecommunications services granted in Docket 09-00113 under Company ID 128879.¹

On September 30, 2009, the Commission granted CBTS, formerly known as Cincinnati Bell Any Distance, Inc., a CCN to provide facilities-based competing local exchange telecommunications service.² CBTS, in its cancellation request, stated that it no longer provides regulated telecommunications services in Tennessee and affirmed that relinquishing its CCN would have no negative effect on the public. CBTS is in good standing with the Commission, and

its inspection fees are current. Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the Commissioners voted unanimously to grant the Company's cancellation request.
