**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY
TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES**

This matter came before Chairman David F. Jones, Vice Chairman Robin L. Morrison and Director Kenneth C. Hill of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on December 12, 2016. Total Call International, Inc. d/b/a Amigos Telecom d/b/a Key Pad d/b/a Star International Alliance ("Total Call" or the "Company") filed an Application for authority to resell interexchange long distance services in Tennessee on September 4, 2009. During a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on February 22, 2010, the Directors found that the Company had met all the requirements for certification and approved the Application. On October 4, 2016, the Authority received a request from Total Call to cancel its authority. The Company stated that it does not have any customers in Tennessee. Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the Directors voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its authority.
