Re: Comcast Application for State-Issued Certificate of Authority

Dear Sirs/Mesdames:

As the City Attorney for Gallatin, Tennessee I received certain correspondence regarding Comcast's application for a state-issued franchise with respect to the City of Gallatin. The correspondence was forwarded from the Mayor's office and included Comcast's notice of intent to apply for this franchise. Unfortunately, I did not receive this notice until the ten (10) day period for preserving PEG channels outlined in T.C.A. § 7-59-309 had expired.

I have since spoken to Douglas Wells, Vice-President, Government & Community Affairs for the Mid-South Region and feel comfortable that Comcast intends to preserve the one PEG channel that is now provided to the City of Gallatin under its most recent local franchise agreement. The City has never received support payments for its PEG channel from Comcast or its predecessors-in-interest.

Even though the City did not respond timely, Mr. Wells asked that I contact the TRA in writing in order to document the file appropriately with respect to this matter.
