**EIGHTH AMENDMENT TO
CERTIFICATE OF FRANCHISE AUTHORITY**

On September 15, 2009, Comcast Cable Communications Management, LLC (“Comcast”) filed its application for a state-issued Certificate of Franchise Authority pursuant to the Competitive Cable and Video Services Act (Tenn. Code Ann. § 7-59-301, *et seq.*, the “Act”). A Certificate of Franchise Authority was granted to Comcast by the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (“TRA,” now the Tennessee Public Utility Commission, “TPUC”) on October 2, 2009.

On August 10, 2010, Comcast filed an Amendment to Certificate of Franchise Authority to supplement certain municipalities and unincorporated areas within counties to those previously described in its 2009 application. An Amended Certificate of Franchise Authority was granted to Comcast by the TRA on September 23, 2010.

On March 29, 2011, Comcast filed a Second Amendment to Certificate of Franchise Authority to effectuate an intercompany transfer of the Certificate in Docket No. 09-00024 into Docket No. 09-00137 and add certain municipalities and unincorporated areas within counties to the description of those areas to be served in whole or in part by Comcast pursuant to its

Certificate, as previously amended. A Second Amended Certificate of Franchise Authority was granted to Comcast by the TRA on April 19, 2011.

On November 22, 2011, Comcast filed a Third Amendment to Certificate of Franchise Authority to add certain municipalities to the description of those areas to be served in whole or in part by Comcast pursuant to its Certificate, as previously amended. A Third Amended Certificate of Franchise Authority was granted to Comcast by the TRA on December 12, 2011.

On March 28, 2013, Comcast filed a Fourth Amendment to Certificate of Franchise Authority to add certain municipalities to the description of those areas to be served in whole or in part by Comcast pursuant to its Certificate, as previously amended. A Fourth Amended Certificate of Franchise Authority was granted to Comcast by the TRA on April 17, 2013.

On July 28, 2017, Comcast filed a Fifth Amendment to Certificate of Franchise Authority to add certain municipalities to the description of those areas to be served in whole or in part by Comcast pursuant to its Certificate, as previously amended. A Fifth Amended Certificate of Franchise Authority was granted to Comcast by the TPUC on August 9, 2017.

On December 15, 2017, Comcast filed a Sixth Amendment to Certificate of Franchise Authority to add certain municipalities and unincorporated areas within counties to the description of those areas to be served in whole or in part by Comcast pursuant to its Certificate, as previously amended. A Sixth Amended Certificate of Franchise Authority was granted to Comcast by the TPUC on January 4, 2018.

On August 27, 2018, Comcast filed a Seventh Amendment to Certificate of Franchise Authority to add certain municipalities and unincorporated areas within counties to the description of those areas to be served in whole or in part by Comcast pursuant to its Certificate,

as previously amended. A Seventh Amended Certificate of Franchise Authority was granted to Comcast by the TPUC on September 7, 2018.

Comcast hereby files this Eighth Amendment to Certificate of Franchise Authority to add the following municipalities and unincorporated areas within counties to the description of those areas to be served in whole or in part by Comcast pursuant to its Certificate, as previously amended:

City of Elizabethton	Metropolitan Lynchburg-Moore County
City of Gilt Edge	Carter County
City of Sunbright	Marion County

Comcast has provided a copy of this Amendment to each of the municipalities and counties listed above. Comcast acknowledges and will comply with all applicable provisions of the Act, including all notice, non-discrimination, and service development requirements, with respect to these municipalities and counties to the same extent as set forth in its original application.

Based on the population of the areas designated above, as required by Tenn. Code Ann. § 7-59-305(b)(2), Comcast hereby submits the required fee of \$500.00 with this Amendment.
