SEVENTH AMENDED CERTIFICATE OF FRANCHISE AUTHORITY

On August 27, 2018, pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 7-59-301, *et seq.*, also known as the Competitive Cable and Video Services Act ("CCVSA"), Comcast Cable Communications Management, LLC ("Comcast") filed with the Tennessee Public Utility Commission ("TPUC") a *Seventh Amendment to Certificate of Franchise Authority*. This amendment supplements certain municipalities and/or unincorporated areas within counties¹ previously described within its application filed September 15, 2009 and previous amendments thereto. As no basis for denial of the amendment under Tenn. Code Ann. § 7-59-305(i)(1) of the CCSVA has been alleged, the TPUC hereby issues the *Seventh Amended Certificate of Franchise Authority* to supplement the original *Certificate of Franchise Authority* issued to Comcast on October 2, 2009 and all amendments issued previously thereafter.
