TENTH AMENDED CERTIFICATE OF FRANCHISE AUTHORITY

On March 14, 2024, pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 7-59-301, *et seq.*, also known as the Competitive Cable and Video Services Act (“CCVSA”), Comcast Cable Communications Management, LLC (“Comcast”) filed with the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) a Tenth *Amendment to Certificate of Franchise Authority*. This amendment supplements certain municipalities and/or unincorporated areas within counties¹ previously described within its application filed September 15, 2009, its renewal filed on September 7, 2020, and previous amendments thereto. As no basis for denial of the amendment under Tenn. Code Ann. § 7-59-305(i)(1) of the CCSVA has been alleged, the Commission hereby issues the Tenth *Amended Certificate of Franchise Authority* to supplement the original *Certificate of Franchise Authority* issued to Comcast on October 2, 2009, the renewal Certificate issued on October 8, 2020, and all amendments issued previously.
