This letter is in response to your September 24, 2009, letter to Blount County requesting information in accordance with Tenn. Code Ann. §§ 7-59-301, *et seq.*


The Blount County Cable Television Authority ("Authority") has franchise agreements with three (3) franchisees to provide cable television service within the unincorporated area of Blount County, Tennessee. These franchisees are Tennessee, LLC, d/b/a Charter Communications ("Charter"); Comcast Cablevision of the South ("Comcast"); and Comcast of Kentucky/Tennessee/Virginia, LLC ("Comcast KY/TN/VA").

Currently, Charter provides two (2) PEG channels, and Comcast and Comcast KY/TN/VA each provide one (1) PEG channel. Charter is required to provide two (2) additional PEG channels upon notice from the Authority. PEG support from each franchisee has been by way of equipment.
