ORDER GRANTING APPROVAL OF NAME CHANGE

This matter came before Director Mary W. Freeman, Director Eddie Roberson and Director Kenneth C. Hill of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on October 26, 2009 upon the petition of Madison River Communications, LLC ("Madison River" or "Company") to change its name.

Madison River was granted authority to provide facilities-based and resold local exchange and interexchange telecommunications services in Docket No. 00-00381 at a Hearing held on August 4, 2000. CenturyTel, Inc. notified the Authority by letter dated September 24, 2007 that it had acquired Madison River on April 30, 2007. Madison River filed a Petition and a correction letter on September 18, 2009 and October 7, 2009, respectively, to change the name under which it provides telecommunications services in Tennessee to Madison River Communications, LLC d/b/a CenturyLink MRC.

Based upon careful consideration of the record in this matter and upon a finding that the Company has satisfied the requirements of Tenn. Comp. R. & Regs. 1220-4-1-.08, the panel voted unanimously to approve the name change.¹
