ORDER GRANTING APPROVAL OF NAME CHANGE

This matter came before Chairman Sara Kyle, Director Kenneth C. Hill and Director Mary W. Freeman of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on October 26, 2009 upon the petition of CenturyTel Fiber Company II, LLC d/b/a LightCore, a CenturyTel Company ("CenturyTel" or "Company") to change its name.

CenturyTel was granted authority to provide local exchange telecommunications services and exchange access under the name Digital Teleport, Inc. ("DTF") in Docket No. 98-00643 at an Authority Conference held on December 8, 1998. A transfer of authority from DTI to CenturyTel Fiber Company II, LLC was approved by the Authority in Docket No. 03-00259 at an Authority Conference held on May 12, 2003. At an Authority Conference held on December 8, 2003, a name change to CenturyTel Fiber Company II, LLC d/b/a LightCore, a CenturyTel Company was approved in Docket No. 03-00555. On September 18, 2009, CenturyTel filed a Petition to change the name under which it provides telecommunications services in Tennessee to CenturyTel Fiber Company II, LLC d/b/a LightCore, a CenturyLink Company.

Based upon careful consideration of the record in this matter and upon a finding that the Company has satisfied the requirements of Tenn. Comp. R. & Regs. 1220-4-1-.08, the panel voted unanimously to approve the name change.¹
